Prior to drafting any contract for goods and services, the responsible party or the decedent's survivor who is handling the funeral arrangements is entitled to receive a copy of any preneed agreement in the possession of the funeral establishment that has been signed and paid for, in full or in part, by or on behalf of the decedent.

SERVICES OF FUNERAL HOME AND STAFF:

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES:

A. MINIMUM SERVICES OF THE FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF: \$2490.00

This fee for our services will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select. (This fee is already included in our charges for direct cremation, immediate burial, and forwarding or receiving remains).

Personnel available 24 hours a day, 365 days a year to respond to initial call.

Arrangement Conference.

Coordinating service plans with cemetery, crematory, and/or other parties involved in the final disposition of the deceased.

Clerical assistance in the completion of various forms associated with a funeral.

Securing and recording the death certificate and disposition permit.

B. ADDITIONAL SERVICES OF THE FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF:

Coordination and direction of the funeral ceremony conducted at the chapel. \$695.00

Coordination and direction of the funeral ceremony conducted at the church, temple, or other facility. \$595.00

Coordination and direction of the funeral ceremony conducted at the place of final disposition. \$300.00

Coordination and direction of a Memorial Ceremony only at mortuary. \$700.00

Supervision and attendants for visitation period, arrangement of floral pieces and tributes per day/evening \$100.00

Additional Charge for Saturday or Sunday Service. \$495.00

Additional Charge for Evening Service or \$100.00

Additional Charge for Holiday Service \$600.00

C. EMBALMING: \$675.00

(Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing.

If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement which does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.)

Other Preparation:

Disinfecting, dressing, casketing and/or cosmetizing of deceased. \$195.00

Bathing, disinfecting and handling of the deceased (unembalmed for 1 time viewing). \$225.00

Special care for autopsied or organ harvested cases \$185.00

Refrigeration. **(3 Days included with purchase of casket)** \$90.00

(California law requires refrigeration of an unembalmed body after 24 hours.)

Use of the facilities for viewing or visitation during regular office hours (9am-5pm, \$320.00

Mon.-Sat, 1pm-4pm, Sunday) per day. For *evening* viewing/visitation add attendant fee.

Preparation room for autopsy by private pathologist/ Washing for religious purposes. \$195.00
